Welcome to the last divination class of this season's issue: tea leaves reading! Most witches love a good cup of loose leaf tea, but did you know that you can predict the future from the dregs

The process of finishing a cup of tea is unique to the drinker - each sip and swirl is natural. which is why the dregs of the loose leaf tea left behind can form shapes that are as unique to the drinker as your fingerprints are.

When you want to start reading your tea leaves, start hovering your eyes around from the stem of the handle, and look for shapes as you turn the cup clockwise.

Use your instinct to interpret the shapes formed by the tea leaves. If your subconscious reads an image as something, pursue that initial thought!

When it comes to observing images in the bottom of the cup, shapes emerging in the white spaces between the tea leaves are good omens, and the images formed by the tea leaves themselves are bad omens.

Letters can be interpreted differently based on capitalisation. Lower case letters may refer to the first letter of someone's name. and capitalised letters may refer to the first letter of a place.

Again, use your intuition to figure out what these mean to you. Think of it like spotting pictures in the clouds! They are merely wisps of what's to come, and who could know your future better than yourself?

The best type of tea to read is loose leaf tea, rather than the ground tea leaves you find inside tea bags, because those won't work. With that in mind, here are some of our favourite homemade tea blends:

FRESH MINT TEA

Pour some boiled water over a handful of fresh mint leaves, let it brew, and add some honey to taste.

RASPBERRY HIBISCUS GREEN TEA

Freeze dry some raspberries and mix with some dried hibiscus petals and jasmine green tea to make your own tasty summer blend!

GINGER DANDELION HERBAL TEA

Roast a cup of dandelion root and mix with a couple spoons of dried ginger root. Yum! 32




About the Zine
